1. Creativity - What it is?

a. Model of thought:

Think of a flower that has the stigma, ovary etc as the heart of Creativity, the petals that add to the beauty, the sepals that support the blossom and the stem that connects it to the mother plant.

 Authority – God is our Creator, He gave His best for our sake both at Creation and at Re-Creation (Calvary).

Luke 12:27 "Consider how the lilies grow. They do not labour or spin. Yet I tell you, not even Solomon in all his splendour was dressed like one of these." This text is the basis for our attitude to creativity. We marvel at it, but we can't explain it. We can analyse it, but we don't really understand the miracle that made it happen. We can only do all the things to cultivate it. We take risks in being creative, but we can only hope that others accept our ideas as we accept theirs.
